








On the first day Cadby met an ant.

ALL ABOUT A BUTTERFLY HATCHING





1. Female and male butterflies mate and then the female lays a tiny egg.
2. The egg hatches and a little caterpillar crawls out!
3. The caterpillar eats and eats until it eventually forms a hard case around itself called a chrysalis.
4. The caterpillar changes into a butterfly inside the chrysalis.



When the butterfly is ready to come out of the chrysalis it chews a hole in the chrysalis and slowly pulls itself out!




See how the butterfly only makes a small hole at one end of the chrysalis?


